Horseback Riders Invited to Participate in LCRVHC Fall Festival Hunter Pace

KILLINGWORTH, CT – The Lower Connecticut River Valley Horsemen's Club (LCRVHC) invites horseback riders of all abilities and disciplines to register for its Fall Festival Hunter Pace. The ride will take place on Sunday, October 29, 2017 in the Weber Woods section of Cockaponset State Forest. Pre-registration is required.

The entry fee is \$45 and entry forms can be downloaded from lcrvhc.org. Fee includes lunch. The registration deadline is October 25, 2017. Late registrations for an additional \$10 may be accepted after that date, space permitting. Prizes will be awarded for top placements and best costumes.

New this year, there will be a silent auction to benefit the Bridle Path Conservancy's work to maintain this trail system. Donations of auction items are welcomed, and cash donations will be accepted on site for the direct benefit of this 501c3 non-profit.

The ride begins at 98 Stevenstown Road, Deep River, and follows a trail within the Deep River and Westbrook sections of Cockaponset State Forest. The terrain is varied and includes open fields, flat stretches through the woods and a few hills; a jump course is optional. Ample trailer parking is available. Check-in begins at 8:30 a.m. and the ride starts at 9:00 a.m. Riders must be checked in and on the trail before 10:30 a.m. to be included in the placings.
